ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

Area of specialisation: CHILD AND ADOLESCENT CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Full-time position: 100%

Profile

- PhD in psychology or equivalent
- Academic teaching experience;
- Desirable clinical experience in the field of child and adolescent psychology and/or school psychology ;
- Interest in fostering strong integration of research and practice;
- Evidence of methodological expertise in the field of child and adolescent psychology and/or school psychology;
- Proven research record in the field of child and adolescent psychology and/or school psychology;
- Good integration into national and international scientific networks; a good knowledge of the Swiss environment would be an asset.

Teaching (43%)

Six hours a week of teaching throughout the year at Bachelor's and Master's level (to be determined according to departmental requirements):

- Bachelor's course: Introduction to child and adolescent clinical psychology (BSc course, 6 ECTS, 2h)
- Master's course in child and adolescent clinical/school psychology according to the candidate's area of expertise and departmental requirements (MSc class or seminar, 3 ECTS, 2h)
- Bachelor's seminar: Elaboration of a research project (BSc seminar, annual, 3 ECTS, 2h)
- Contribution to the clinical activity of the Child and adolescent service (equivalent to 10%)

Supervision of Master's dissertations and PhD theses.

This part of the job specifications will be reassessed after two years, at the time of the retirement of the person in charge of the Child and adolescent clinical service. Some teaching responsibilities may be redefined according to departmental requirements.

Research (45%)

The post-holder will pursue their own research in the field of child and adolescent psychology and/or school psychology. It is expected that the post-holder will encourage the development of research in conjunction with the Consultation service and contribute to the expansion of the clinical consultation services within the Institute of Psychology. The post-holder will be affiliated to one of the Institute of Psychology's research centres. S/he will be expected to promote research and to produce high-quality academic publications.

S/he will seek external funding, in particular from the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF).

Administrative responsibilities (12%)

In accordance with statutory requirements and in the name of collegiality, the post-holder will take on any administrative tasks that may be assigned to them by the Institute, Faculty, University or university decision-making bodies.

The post-holder will take over responsibility for child and adolescent consultations when the current person in charge will retire.

Institutional environment

The post is located in the Institute of Psychology (IP) and the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences.
